

## Dependent Resurvey of Base Line, Portion of S. Bdy. of T. 1 N., R. 9 W.

	<p>A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 52° W., 81 lks. dist., mkd. T1N R9W S32 BT.</p> <p>Land, mountainous with steep general N. slope. Soil, rocky clay with rock outcroppings. Timber, hemlock, spruce, fir, and alder; undergrowth, salmonberry, devil's-club, sword fern, huckleberry, thimbleberry, vine maple, and reproduction.</p>
	<p>N. 89° 11' W., along the S. bdy. of Section 32.</p> <p>Ascend 155 ft. over E. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
3.20	Spur, slopes N. 10° E.; descend 20 ft. along broken N. slope.
10.50	Spur, slopes N.; descend 110 ft. over NW. slope.
12.75	Branch, 1 lk. wide, course N.; ascend 87 ft. over NE. slope.
15.40	Spur, slopes N.; descend 200 ft. over NW. slope.
20.16	Branch, 1 lk. wide, course N.; ascend 228 ft. over E. slope.
25.26	Spur, slopes N. 30° E.; descend 152 ft. along N. slope, changing to NW. slope.
31.85	Branch, 2 lks. wide, course N.; ascend 22 ft. over E. slope.
32.70	Top of ascent, slopes N. 10° E.; descend 51 ft. over steep W. slope.
33.80	Branch, 1 lk. wide, course N.; ascend 200 ft. over steep E. slope.
37.60	Spur, slopes N. 20° E.; descend 1 ft. along N. slope.
38.715	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of Section 5 only, on the N. bdy. of T. 1 S., R. 9 W., hereinafter described.
	Descend 4 ft. along N. slope.
39.16	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of Section 32 only, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

49.60	Branch, 1 lk. wide, course N. 10° W.; descend 76 ft. along N. slope.
58.52	Point for the W $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of Section 5 only, on the N. bdy. of T. 1 S., R. 9 W.
