	<p style="text-align: center;">T 1 S R 9 W S 23 S 13 S 24 1938</p> <p>from which</p> <p>A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears N. $20\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 217$\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. T1S R9W S13 BT.</p> <p>A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears S. $57\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 184 lks. dist., mkd. T1S R9W S24 BT.</p> <p>From this point a locally established cor., bears N. 45° W., 14 lks. dist., monumented with a spruce limb, 4 ins. diam., protruding $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above ground, firmly set, in a small mound of stones.</p> <p>Ascend 110 ft. over SE. slope.</p>
37.03	<p>The cor. of secs. 14 and 23 on the W. bdy. of sec. 13, determined at record bearing and distance from the remains of the original bearing trees, recorded and monumented by the Oregon State Board of Forestry with an iron post, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., protruding 15 ins. above ground, firmly set, with 3 in. bronze cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Oregon State Board of Forestry T 1 S R 9 W S 14 S 13 S 23 1938 RE 2311</p> <p>from which the remains of the original bearing trees:</p> <p>A rotted and burned hemlock stub, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 34° W., 17 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on burned face.</p> <p>A stump hole, bears N. 17° W., 22 lks. dist.</p> <p>and tree marked by the Oregon State Board of Forestry in 1934:</p> <p>A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 69° W., 114 lks. dist., with scribe marks T1S R9W S23 BT visible on partially healed blaze.</p> <p>A spruce, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 72° W., 75 lks. dist., with scribe marks T1S R9W S14 BT RE2311 visible on partially healed blaze.</p> <p>Add marks BLM 1938 to the bronze cap.</p> <p>Land, mountainous except for narrow Wilson River bottom at S. end. Soil, rocky clay with loam in the river bottom. Timber, all burned off except for young hemlock, spruce, fir, and alder, with asple and cottonwood in the river bottom; undergrowth, salmonberry, salal, wild blackberry, and fern.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 13 and 24 only, on the E. bdy. of the township. N. $85^{\circ} 23'$ W., bet. secs. 13 and 24.</p> <p>Descend 107 ft. over steep rocky W. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
2.16	Branch, 1 lk. wide, course N. 80° W.; desc. 75 ft. over W. slope.
6.00	Left bank of Wilson River, course S. 30° W.
7.90	Right bank of river; asc. 377 ft. over SE. slope, changing to S. slope.
