

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 1 S., R. 9 W.

Chains	
8.60	Spur ridge, bears N. 75° E. and S. 75° W.; desc. 450 ft. over NW. slope.
19.73	Little North Fork of Wilson River, 75 lks. wide, course S. 70° W.; asc. 25 ft. over SE. slope.
20.20	Trail, bears NE. and W.
22.80	Dry bed of creek, 3 lks. wide, course S. 30° E.; asc. 283 ft. over SE. slope.
26.00	Enter old growth timber, edge bears E. and W.
30.80	Spur, slopes S. 20° W.; asc. 27 ft. over SW. slope.
33.02	The cor. of secs. 12 and 13, on the E. bdy. of sec. 14, determined at record bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing tree, recorded and remonumented by the Oregon State Board of Forestry with an iron post, 1½ ins. diam., protruding 4 ins. above ground, firmly set, with 3 in. bronze cap mkd.

from which the original bearing tree:

A sawed hemlock stump, 62 ins. diam., bears N. 64° E., 54 lks. dist., with scribe marks S12 BT visible on opened blaze, and scribe marks T1S R9W visible on opened blaze on trunk of log which has slid downhill and covered the point for the original SE. bearing tree,

and trees marked by the Oregon State Board of Forestry in 1957:

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 37½° E., 117½ lks. dist., with scribe marks T1S R9W S12 BT visible on partially healed blaze,

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 75¼° E., 111½ lks. dist., with scribe marks T1S R9W S13 BT BS401 visible on partially healed blaze.

Add marks BLM 1958 to the bronze cap.

N. 5° 26' W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 78 ft. over SW. slope, changing to W. slope.

3.06 The cor. of secs. 11 and 14, on the W. bdy. of sec. 12, determined at record bearing and distance from the remaining original bearing tree:

A hemlock, 55 ins. diam., bears S. 84° W., 70 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on opened blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
