

## Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 1 S., R. 9 W.

Point for the N 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 11.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 54 1/2° E., 44 lks. dist.,  
mkd. N 1/16 S11 BT.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 82 1/2° W., 29 lks. dist.,  
mkd. N 1/16 S10 BT.

Descend 140 ft. over NW. slope.

20.60 Spring seepage, drains NW.; asc. 68 ft. along W. slope.

27.00 Spur, slopes N. 80° W.; desc. 367 ft. over steep N. slope.

33.40 Leave timber, edge bears E. and W.; enter old logged area covered with dense undergrowth.

36.64 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10, and 11, determined from the remaining original bearing trees, recorded and remonumented by the Oregon State Board of Forestry with an iron post, 1 1/2 ins. diam., protruding 6 ins. above ground, firmly set, with 3 in. bronze cap mkd.

A hemlock snag, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 15° E., 16 lks. dist.,  
(25 lks. slope distance) with scribe marks S R9 11 visible  
on partially opened blaze. (Record, S. 9 1/2° E., 25 lks. dist.)

A saved hemlock stump, 29 ins. diam., bears S. 75° W.,  
72 1/2 lks. dist. (83 lks. slope distance), with scribe  
marks S visible on partially opened blaze. (Record,  
S. 70 1/2° W., 83 lks. dist.)

A saved hemlock stump, 40 ins. diam., bears N. 59 1/2° W.,  
79 lks. dist. (level), with scribe mark S visible on  
partially opened blaze.

and trees marked by the Oregon State Board of Forestry in 1957:

An alder, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 46° E., 19 lks. dist.,  
bark scribed T1S R9W S2 BT.

An alder, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 55° E., 44 lks. dist.,  
bark scribed T1S R9W S11 BT RS401.

An alder, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 67° W., 24 lks. dist.,  
bark scribed T1S R9W S10 BT.

A hemlock, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 32° W., 159 lks. dist.,  
with scribe marks T1S R9W S3 BT visible on unhealed blaze.
