

Dependent Resurvey of Portion of Subdivisional Lines of T. 1 S., R. 9 W.

Chains

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay with rock outcroppings.
Timber, hemlock, fir, spruce, and alder; undergrowth, sword fern, devil's-club, vine maple, huckleberry, salmonberry, young alder, and reproduction.

To complete the survey of sec. 2, I return to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 35 only, on the S. bdy. of sec. 35, T. 1 N., R. 9 W., and run N. 87° 17' E., along the N. bdy. of sec. 2.

3.245 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 2 only, at midpoint in departure on the N. bdy. of sec. 2.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 28 ins. diam., bears S. 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 212 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S2 BT.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 130 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S2 BT.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 16, determined at record bearing and distance from the remaining bearing tree established by the County Surveyor about 80 years ago in a perpetuation of the original corner.

from which the remaining County Surveyor bearing tree:

An alder, 37 ins. diam., bears N. 72° E., 87 lks. dist., bark scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S CS.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 183 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S15 BT.

A spruce, 38 ins. diam., bears S. 26° W., 94 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S16 BT.

From this point a locally established cor., bears N. 9° W., 190 lks. dist., monumented with a drive shaft housing, 2 ins. diam., protruding 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. above ground, firmly set, alongside the cor. of fences bearing N. 10° E., S. 10° W., and N. 80° W.

N. 0° 10' W., bet. secs. 15 and 16.

Ascend 345 ft. over S. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
