Chains	<p>A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears N. 56° E., 32 lks. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S10 BT.</p> <p>A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 45° W., 20 lks. dist., mkd. N 1/16 S9 BT.</p> <p>Descend 410 ft. over steep, rocky NW. slope.</p> <p>Leave timber, edge bears E. and W.; enter open logged area.</p> <p>Roxed logging road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 60° E. and SW.</p> <p>Wet ravine, drains N. 20° E.; desc. 20 ft. along E. slope.</p> <p>Point of spur, slopes NE.; desc. 57 ft. over steep NE. slope.</p> <p>Branch, 1 lk. wide, course NE.; desc. 5 ft. along E. slope.</p> <p>Low spur, slopes N. 50° E.; desc. 67 ft. over steep N. slope.</p> <p>Branch, 3 lks. wide, course N. 70° E.; desc. 6 ft. along E. slope.</p> <p>Wet ravine, drains E.; asc. 100 ft. over SE. slope.</p> <p>The cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9, and 10, determined from the remaining original bearing trees, recorded and recommended by the Oregon State Board of Forestry with an iron post, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., protruding 4 ins. above ground, firmly set, with 3 in. bronze cap mkd.</p>

	<p>from which the remaining original bearing trees:</p> <p>An uprooted and rotted alder, bears N. $43\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 63 lks. dist., with no marks remaining.</p> <p>A hemlock, 21 ins. diam., bears S. 60° E., 6 lks. dist., with scribe marks S R9 visible on partially opened blaze. (Record, S. $64\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 60 lks. dist.)</p> <p>A hemlock, 23 ins. diam., bears S. 20° W., 21 lks. dist., with scribe marks T1S R9W S9 BT visible on opened blaze. (Record bearing, S. 24° W.)</p>
	<p>and a tree marked by the Oregon State Board of Forestry in 1958:</p> <p>A hemlock, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 83° E., $13\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with scribe marks T1S R9W S3 BT RS 401 visible on unhealed blaze.</p> <p>Add marks BLM 1959 to the bronze cap and mark a new bearing tree:</p> <p>A hemlock, 39 ins. diam., bears N. 62° W., 108 lks. dist., mkd. T1S R9W S4 BT.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, spruce, and alder; undergrowth, sword fern, huckleberry, vine maple, salal, devil's-club, and reproduction.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10, and 11.</p> <p>S. $59^{\circ} 34' W.$, bet. secs. 3 and 10.</p>
