I found a 2" x 2" squared fir post 48" above ground in good  
condition set by M. Whitmore 2-28-51.

I found the orig. 50" snag, N.29°E., (not N.33°E. as in orig.  
record) 53 lks. with the lower half of a "B" visible.

The S.W. and S.E., and N.W. BT<sup>s</sup> are in their proper bearings  
and distances but all marks are rotted away.

I set 1" pipe 2 ft. above ground and mark 4 new BT<sup>s</sup>.
