

Resurvey of Portion of North Boundary of

T. 3 S., R. 10 W.

Chains.

S. 89° 42' W., on true line on S. bdy. of sec. 34.

Asc. 50 ft. over gradual, broken NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

7.30 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW.

10.30 Desc. 25 ft. over gradual NW. slope.

14.70 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NW., asc. 218 ft. over E. slope.

28.10 Spur, slopes S., desc. 41 ft. over W. slope.

30.98 True point for closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, as hereinafter determined.

32.10 Small saddle on top of ridge, bears N. and S., asc. 115 ft. over E. slope.

39.91 Cor. of secs. 33 and 34 only, which is a piece of stake, very rotten, from which

Old snag, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 46° E., 46 lks. dist., mkd. S 33 B T. (Old B. T.)

A hemlock, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 27° W., (not S. 4° E.) 17 lks. dist., marks grown over. (Old B. T.)

A hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 62½° W., (not N. 64° W., 35 lks.) 37 lks. dist., mkd. S 33 B T. (Old B. T.)

At point for cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of secs. 33 and 34 only, with brass cap mkd.

Timber, hemlock, spruce, cedar, and alder.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, salal, alder, fern, Devil's club, and wild blackberry.
