A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 87° E., (not N. 37° E.) 12 lks. dist., mkd. S 4 B. T. (Old B. T.)

A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 25° W., (not N. 41° W.) 26 lks. dist., marks grown over. (Old B. T.)

A hemlock, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 67½° E., (not S. 84° E., 22 lks. dist., marks grown over. (Old B. T.)

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 82° W., (not S. 88° W.) 11 lks. dist., marks grown over. (Old B. T.)

This cor. is on top of ridge, bears NW. and SE.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy loam, 3rd rate.

Timber, hemlock, spruce, fir, alder, and cedar.

Undergrowth, vinemaple, salal, fern, alder, Devil's club, and wild blackberry.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9.

N.0°01'W., record bearing, on true line bet. secs. 4 and 5.

Desc. 186 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

8.30 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.20°E., over rolling land.

10.00 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course E., desc. 38 ft. over N. slope.

13.14 Creek, 8 lks. wide, course SE., asc. 49 ft. over SE. slope.
