By request Jim Russell, OSBF, wishes the corner restoration record in our office pertaining to the standard section corner between 33-34 south boundary T. 5S., R. 9W. to be filed in the Tillamook County Courthouse as soon as possible.

G.L.O. 1880 set a post and marked 3 witnesses:  
4" Hemlock, N.78°W., 54 LKS.  
5" Fir, S.48°E., 15 LKS.  
6" Fir, S.44°W., 18 LKS.

1887 the Tillamook County surveyor set a post and marked 2 witnesses:  
40" Snag, N.40°E., 15 FT.  
30" Snag, N.23°W., 18½ FT.

He did not record having found any of the original G.L.O. witnesses.

In 1958 Mervin Whitmore, Tillamook County Deputy Surveyor, found the 1887 Tillamook County surveyor's post, squared at the top, in poor condition. He found a 40" snag, N.40°E., 15 FT., as recorded, with the marks "BT" visible and a 30" snag, N.23°W., 18½ FT. as recorded with visible but not legible marks.

Whitmore set ½ pipe 18" high alongside old post.
