

CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 4, Township 6 South, Range 9 West, Willamette Meridian, Tillamook and Yamhill Counties, Oregon.

ORIGINAL (By Wygant in 1908 retracement).

Fir post (missing - point falls under road - see restoration by L. Whitmore), from which a:

8" Fir bears S 89 E 37 lks.; now missing.

6" Fir bears S 86 W 42 lks.; now missing.

RESTORATION by L. Whitmore August 25, 1965.

4" x 4" x 8' white painted Fir post (found, scribed 1/4 on North, S3 on East and S4 on West sides) from which a:

30" Fir bears S 28 1/2 W 27.5 ft.; now 37", scribe marks partially grown over.

34" Fir bears S 13 E 25.0 ft.; now 40" scribe marks partially grown over.

RESTORED

Set 1 1/2" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S3 S4 1968 RS 707" in place of scribed white post, 30 inches in ground, 15' South of center-line of a road (bears N 80 W by N 75 E), and in mound of rock.

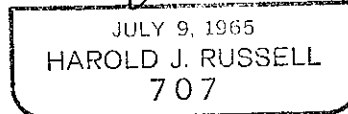
Set 4" x 4" x 8' white painted Fir post 1.3 ft. N 45 W of corner pipe. U. S. Forest Service metal location posters on both BTs.
