

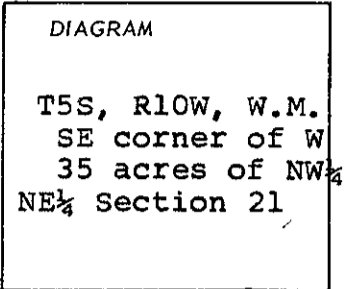
County Surveyor's Record, Tillamook County, Oregon

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

(Reference FSH 5681.65)

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was established in 1956 by John C. Carlich (ORLS 287).



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch by 24 inch iron pipe for the corner from which:

A hemlock, 32 inches in diameter bears N44E, 18.2 feet slope distance

A hemlock, 24 inches in diameter bears S80 $\frac{1}{2}$ E, 17.9 feet distance

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the corner point set a 2 inch by 30 inch cement filled iron pipe with brass cap marked

T5S R10W

SE Cor

1968

ORLS 650

Deposited the iron pipe beside the monument.

Placed U.S.F.S. bearing tree signs on all BT's facing the monument.
