Section corner common to Sections 23, 24, 25, and 26, Township 3 South, Range 7 West, Willamette Meridian, Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone 18" x 12" x 8" (found in place, 4 notches on N side and 1 on East side) from which a:

Nestucca River, course SW, bears North 1.15 chs.; now in place course S 80 W, 35 feet wide.

Nestucca River, course SW, bears West 1.45 chs.; now 298', course SSW, 35' feet wide.

Original Blaze bears South 40'; on 12" pitchy Fir stub.

Also poster on 4" x 4" x 60" Fir post on North edge Nestucca River, bears N 8½ W 208.6 ft.

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON—DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

CHAINS

West one-sixteenth corner common to Sections 2 and 11, Township 1 North, Range 10 West, Willamette Meridian, Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL (established by Oregon State Board of Forestry, 1959)

1½" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap (found in place, marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY W 1/16 S2 S11 1959 RS 401") from which a:

27" Hemlock bears S 64 E 6.9 ft.; now uprooted, with face and scribes underneath.

27" Hemlock bears N 15 E 27.2 ft.; now 27" Stub, 2' high, scribes visible in partially grown over face.

4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post bears SE 1.0 ft.; in place.

6" Hemlock bears S 30½ W 14.8 ft.; scribed W 1/16 S11 BT.
