CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 34 and 35, Township 3 South, Range 7 West, Willamette Meridian, Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone, 16" x 12" x 6" (in place 1/4 on West face.)

RESTORED

Var 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ E

Marked X in top of original stone and erected mound of stone around it, from which a:

21" Fir bears N 75 $\frac{1}{4}$ E 12.1 ft.; scribed 1/4 S35 BT.
17" Fir bears S 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 15.3 ft.; scribed 1/4 S34 BT RS 707.
Hoag Pass Road bears North 150 ft.; course N 20 W by S 40 E.
Found original blazes South of corner.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NW of corner stone.
Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 25" Fir stub S 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 12.1 ft.
Also poster on 2" x 4" x 36" pitch stake in 4" Fir stump, 45' South of Road, N 82E 87.3'.
