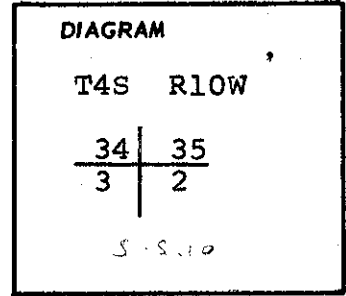


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

scribed - with tag

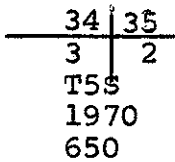
37" spruce brs. N45W 40.0 ft
