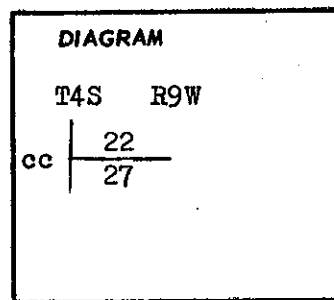


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTS

History of original corner establishment:

Corner set by Charles Branson in 1898. No BTs .
Set 12x10x8" stone.
M. Whitmore found corner in 1961 and scribed 2 BTs.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found a 10"x8"x6" stone with S22 on NE face and S27 on SE face.
Three notches on east edge and two notches on south edge. from which

A 20" fir brs. N26E 17.0 ft
face healed (M. Whitmore 2/11/61)

16" fir brs. S40W 7.0 ft
face healed (M. Whitmore 2/11/61)

NE corner Section 28 brs. North 53.5 feet marked by stone and brass cap

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set a 2"x30" iron pipe with brass cap marked

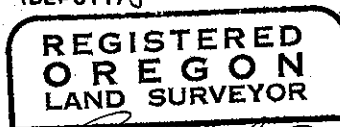

Painted strip on BTs. BT signs in place.

Set original stone beside brass cap.
