July 1893: Section Corner, Common to 18 & 19, T3N, ~~R5W~~ & 13 & 24, T3N, R6W. Govt. BT'S are:

- Hemlock 10" dia. N 44° 15' E 20 lks, down & marks not visible
 - Hemlock 8" dia. S 44° 15' W 22 lks. Marked S 24 on N.W. Face.
 - Hemlock 8" dia. S 74° 45' W 13 lks.
- No other BT'S to be found.

Set a 4" x 4" x 4" Hemlock post 2' in ground, marked

T3N S 13	T3N S 18
R6W S 24	R5W S 19

3 notches on N. & S.

from which:

- Fir 50" dia. N. 40° 31' E 79 lks. Marked T3N S 18 BT
- Hemlock 24" dia. S 41° 45' E 64 lks. Marked R5W S 19 BT
- Hemlock 8" dia. S 62° W 72 lks. Marked R6W S 24 BT
- Fir 48" dia. N 36° 15' W 36 lks. Marked S 13 BT
