

In my opinion, Caudle's township corner must be accepted for two reasons:

1. Caudle used his corner to establish the east boundary of T. 3 S., R. 9 W.
2. Henry Meldrum by GLO contact, April 24, 1884, established the north boundary of T. 4 S., R. 8 W. and tied into Caudle's recorded set township corner T. 3-4 S., R. 8-9 W.
