CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 26, 27, 34 and 35, T3S, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County.

ORIGINAL

Post (missing) from which a:

- 72" Fir bears N26 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 33 lks.; now 60" badly rotted stub, face and scribes rotted away.
- 72" Fir bears S29W 64 lks.; now 36" badly rotted stub, face and scribes rotted away.
- 34" Fir bears S45E 88 lks.; now 40" badly rotted stub, face and scribes rotted away.
- 28" Fir bears N67 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 82 lks.; now 36" badly rotted stub, face and scribes rotted away (34.3 ft.).

RESTORATION by Leonard Whitmore, November 30, 1963

3" x 3" Vine maple stake (found 1' West of corner point) from which a:

- 18" Fir bears S10E 80 lks.; now 20", face grown over.
- 38" Fir bears S13W 39 lks.; now 41", face grown over.
- 15" Fir bears N16W 53 lks.; now 18", face grown over.
- 18" Alder bears N18E 48 lks.; now 21", bark scribes T3S R8W S26 BT visible.

RESTORED

Var. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ E

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T3S R8W S27 S26 S34 S35 1969 RS707", 20 inches in ground, and in a hole chopped through a 22" hollow log.

Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 18" Fir BT (N14 3/4W).

Set Whitmore's vine maple 3" x 3" x 5' stake 1.0 N.W. of corner pipe.
