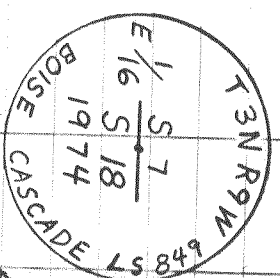

CONCRETE FILLED, GALV. IRON  
PIPE WITH 2" BRASS CAP  
STAMPED AS SHOWN:

TO FACE SCRIBED "E 1/6 S 7 BT"

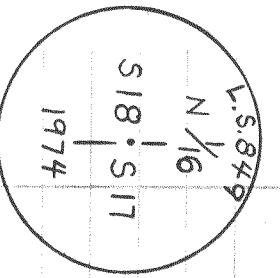
