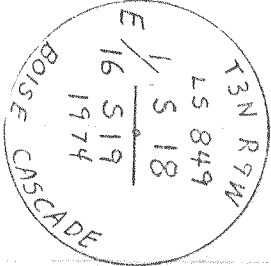

 SCRIBED "E 1/6 S 18 BT"

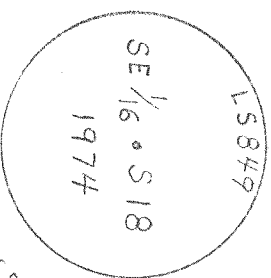
A 16" ALDER BEARS N 35°E
