CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to Sections 18 and 19, T2S, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

30" Spruce (now 41" x 6" tall Hemlock stump, scribes R8W remaining on partially grown over face on NE side and T2S remaining on partially grown over face on SE side), from which a:

- 8" Spruce bears S28°E 15 lks.; now 6" x 4' tall stub, scribes BT visible on exposed face.
- 18" Spruce bears N60°E 55 lks.; missing in creek bottom.
- Found Hemlock N16°W 66.6 ft. not mentioned in original field notes; now 26" x 5' tall stump, scribes T2S R9W S13 remaining on partially grown over face.

RESTORATION by J. S. Forrest, 1950

1½" x 5" iron pipe 30" in ground between knees of corner tree stump on north side (found N36°E 0.8' from true center of stump) from which a:

- 16" Hemlock bears N32°E 137 ft.; now 25" face grown over.
- 6" Hemlock bears S47°E 127 ft.; now 16" face grown over.

RESTORED

Var. 21½°E

Set 1½" x 18" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2S R9W S24 T2S R8W S18 S19 1975 RS707", 16 inches in center of corner tree stump, and from which a:

- 12" Alder bears S46½°E 50.5 ft. to face; bark scribed T2S R8W S19 BT.
- 17" Spruce bears N60°E 126.2 ft. to face; scribed T2S R8W S18 BT RS707.
- 1' wide creek bears North 38.0 ft., course N81°W from S64°E.

Set 4" x 4" x 5' white painted Cedar post 4.4 ft. NE of corner pipe. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 12" Alder BT S46½°E 50.5 ft. Also poster on 8" Spruce N64°W 10.4 ft.
