RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 2, and 11, T3N, R8W, W.M.,
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Stone 18" x 12" x 8", missing from which a:

40" Fir bears S57°W 45 lks.; now burnt root crown.

30" Fir bears N51°W 17 lks.; now 30" uproot, roots in place, scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT,
Top of spur bears East 1.5 chs. lks.; now 147 feet, slopes N10° E.

Var. 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° East

Set 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON
STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T3N R8W $\frac{1}{4}$ S2 S11 1979 RS 707", 34 inches
in ground; and from which a:

14" Fir bears S32°W 16.9 ft. to face; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S11 BT RS 707.

12" Fir bears N48°E 8.7 ft. to face; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S2 BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NW of corner pipe.
