

Remonumentation of Certain Original Corner Points,  
T. 4 S., R. 9 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S.  $30\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 60 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S16 BT.

Deposit corner stone and set a 5 ft. steel fence post alongside iron post.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 4, perpetuated and recorded by Mervin Whitmore, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1953, monumented with a fir post, 5 ins. square, lying on the ground, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A sawed fir stump, 40 ins. diam., bears S.  $23\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 49 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on open blaze.

and bearing trees mkd. by Whitmore

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S.  $73^{\circ}$  E., 4 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears N.  $59^{\circ}$  W., 32 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Reset fir post and set a 5 ft. steel fence post alongside iron post.

The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21, perpetuated and recorded by Leonard Whitmore, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1961, monumented with the original basalt stone, 12 x 10 x 10 ins., firmly set, 8 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 6 ins. high, mkd. with  $\frac{1}{4}$  S16 on N. and  $\frac{1}{4}$  S21 on S. faces, from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A sawed fir stump, 38 ins. diam., bears N.  $48\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 281 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on opened blaze.

and the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Whitmore

A sawed fir stump, 14 ins. diam., bears S.  $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W.,  $121\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., with scribe marks  $\frac{1}{4}$  S21 visible on open blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
