CHAINS

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Meander corner common to Sections 13 and 18, T3N, R8&9W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon, (on left bank of Nehalem River.)

ORIGINAL

Basalt stone 16" x 10" x 5", now missing, from which a:

9" Ash bears S86°W 46 lks.; now missing.

15" Ash bears S63°E 46 lks.; now missing.

REWITNESSED by Richard A. Morris, May 22, 1957.

Mound of stone on East side of MC stone, now in place, from which a:

20" Hemlock bears S33°W 90.9 ft.; now 29", face grown over. (This tree located on South edge Nehalem River Road.)

14" Alder bears S47°E 16.8 ft.; now 15", bark scribes T3N R8W S18 MC BT visible.

Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 8" Alder bears N80°W 18.5 ft.; now 12", poster missing.

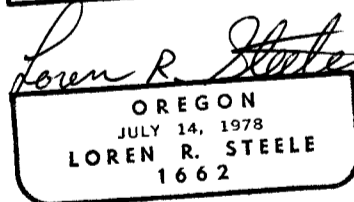
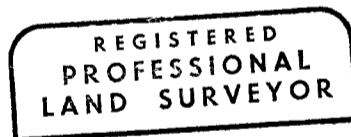
Chiseled an X in bedrock, then set 1½" x 6" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY MC S13 S18 R9W R8W T3N 1982 RS 1662", concreted in mound of rock, over X, and from which a:

24" Alder bears S53°W 31.0 ft. to face; bark scribed T3N R9W S13 MC BT.

Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 24" Alder BT. Also poster on 20" Hemlock BT.
