REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Township corner common to Sections 1, 6, 31, and 36, T 1 & 2 N,  
R 6 & 7 W, W.M. Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL:

Basalt stone 18"x12"x6" (missing) from which a:

48" Fir bears N05°W 37 lks.; now 50" stump, face burnt, axe  
work and portion of scribe visible.

40" Fir bears S72°W 16 lks.; now 40" stump, face burnt, axe  
work visible.

36" Fir bears S58°E 50 lks.; missing, point falls in old slide.

48" Fir bears N40°E 67 lks.; missing, point falls on old slide.

RESTORATION by J.E. Scott, RE 294, March 1943 (Recorded in Book 1,  
page 169, Tillamook County Surveyors Office).

1¼"x60" iron pipe, 58" in ground, with 2" brass cap marked "T2NR7W  
36 31 1 6 T1NR7W" (in place).

Did not mark bearing trees.

REWITNESSED:

Var. 21½°E

From above pipe, added marks "RS 1998 1982", and from which a:

6" Fir bears S60°E 9.8 ft. to face; scribe T1NR6W S6 BT.

6" Fir bears N33°E 31.4 ft. to face, scribe T2NR6W S31 BT.

40" Fir stump bears S60°W 9.2 ft. to face, scribed T1NR7W S1  
BT below original face.
