

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One-Quarter corner common to Sections 2 and 35, T3&4N, R6W, W.M., Tillamook and Clatsop
ORIGINAL Counties, Oregon.

Post (missing). from which a:

10" cedar bears N32°W 17 lks.; now a 10" cedar uproot with scribes visible.
26" hemlock bears S54°W 21 lks.; now a 30" hemlock stump, face and scribes rotted away.

RESTORATION by OSHD, 1941.

Found 2 dead BT's.

Set a 2" x 48" galvanized iron pipe with brass cap (in place).

Set 4" x 4" white guard post (in place).

Did not scribe BT's.

Above mentioned 2" x 48" pipe, from which a:

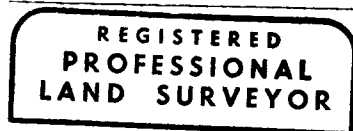
14" fir bears N46°E 5.7 ft. to face; scribed 1/4 S35 BT.

11" fir bears S233/4°E 30.8 ft. to face; scribed 1/4 S2 BT.
