RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON--DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 23 and 26, T2N, R9W, W.M.,
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, July 25, 1884.

Post (missing) from which a:

30" Fir bears N76°W 36 lks.; now 35" snag, 30' high, scribes
/4S BT visible, cruiser marks above scribing.
16" Hemlock bears S83°E 6 lks.; missing.

RESTORED

VAR. 21½°E

Set 1½" X 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked
"OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2N R9W ¼ S23 S26 1984 RS1998",
34 inches in ground, and from which a:

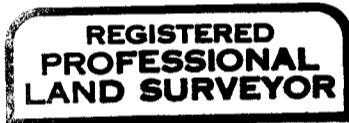
5" Fir bears S86°E 52.0 ft. to face; scribed X BT.
53" Fir snag bears S11°E 27.6 ft. to face; scribed ¼S26BT.
Snag 20' high.

Set 4X4X60" white painted Cedar post 1.2 ft. N30°W of corner pipe.
Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 53" Fir
snag BT.

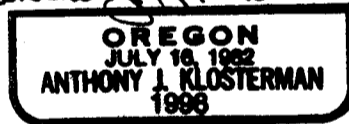
