

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON -- DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Line Tree common to Sections 17 and 18, T3N, R7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

70" fir line tree; now a 70" fir stump with no marks visible.
Only one other 70" fir stump in the area, but it is too far East to fit ridge calls to the South.

Ridge bears South 4 chains; in place
82" line tree between Sections 19 and 20 bears S0° 26'10"E 7017.12'; in place.

RESTORED: VAR 21 1/2°E

Set 5/8" x 30" iron rod with yellow plastic cap marked PLS1662 24" into center of 70" line tree stump; and from which a:

- 14" fir bears S30°E 26.7 ft. to face; scribed WP S17 BT.
 - 15" fir bears S82°W 19.7 ft. to face; scribed WP S18 BT.
- Corner falls on steep North slope.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post S.E. 1.0 ft. from iron rod. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 15" fir BT.
