

RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

Line tree corner common to Sections 1 and 12, T2N, R8W, W.M.,  
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, August 4, 1893.

72" Spruce bears  $S89^{\circ}31'W$  14.20 chains from the section  
corner common to sections 1, 6, 7 and 12; now a 72" stump, in  
place, on north edge of old cat road, 2 notches on East and West  
sides, notches on West side and 1 notch on East side exposed,  
other notch grown over.

RESTORED November 24, 1987

Var.  $21\ 1/2^{\circ}E$

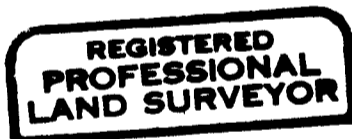
Set  $5/8"x36"$  steel rebar with yellow plastic cap marked  
"LS1998", 30 inches into center of stump, and from which a:

16" Noble Fir bears  $S15^{\circ}E$  29.3 ft. to face; scribed WPS12BT.  
13" Fir bears  $S49^{\circ}E$  53.7 ft. to face; scribed WPS12BT.

Metal location posters on BT's.

$3/4"$  brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of BTs.
