

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

East One-Sixteenth corner common to Sections 1 and 12, T3N, R10W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Richard A. Morris LS401, February 13, 1963, (See Plat# B-473, Tillamook Co. Records).

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 35" in ground; in place, and from which a:

18" Hemlock bears S71°W 6.2 ft.; now a 21"x6ft. high badly rotted stub, face laying on ground with portions of scribes visible.

20" Hemlock bears N48°E 1.6 ft.; now a 18" badly rotted stump, no scribes visible, face rotted off.

4"x4"x56" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NW; in place.

Metal location poster on 10" Hemlock N70°W 6.2 ft.; now a badly rotted stub, tag missing.

Var. 21 1/2°E

From the above pipe with marks "1988 LS1998" added, and from which a:

8" Fir bears N56°W 15.7 ft. to face scribed E1/16S1BT.

10" Fir bears S02°E 10.3 ft. to face scribed E1/16S12BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
