Tillamook County, Oregon.

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in ground;
in place, and from which a:

12" Hemlock bears N12 1/2W 14.7 ft.; now a 12" badly rotted
stub, face has rotted off.

17" Hemlock bears N89E 51.4 ft.; missing, torn out by road
construction.

4"x4"x60" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NE; in place.

REWITNESSED February 12, 1988 Var. 21 1/2 E
From the above pipe with marks "1988 LS1998" added, and from
which a:

10" Hemlock bears S12E 16.0 ft. to face; scribed CW1/16S12BT.

12" Fir bears N29E 33.6 ft. to face; scribed CW1/16S12BT.

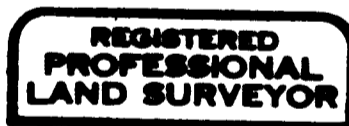
Centerline Coal Creek road bears East 37.9 ft.; road bears
