

**RESTORED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY**

Section corner common to Sections 25, 36, 30 and 31, T2S, R6&7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

**ORIGINAL** by Caudle & Brand, November 1, 1879.

Post; missing.

- 10" Hemlock bears N70E 8 lks.; missing.
- 13" Hemlock bears S40W 115 lks.; now rotten remains of uproot.
- 12" Hemlock bears N80W 40 lks.; missing.
- 20" Hemlock bears S45E 34 lks.; missing, point falls in old cat road.

**RESTORATION** by L.H.L. Lumber Corporation, 1951 (unrecorded).

1/2" iron pipe with 2" bronze cap; missing.

**RESTORATION** by Louis W. Amort RE2311, August 15, 1952 (Book 2, page 166, Tillamook County Records).

Raised mound of stone around pipe; missing, point falls under windfall.

- 60" Fir Stump bears N39E 62.2 ft.; now 60" badly rotted with scribes T2S R6W S30 BT RE23 visible.
- 42" Fir Stump bears N64 1/2W 37.5 ft.; now 42" badly rotted with scribes T2S R7W S25 BT visible.
- 49" Fir Stump bears S56W 65.5 ft.; now 49" badly rotted with scribes T2S R7W S36 BT visible.
- 66" Fir Stump bears S54E 73.6 ft.; now 62" badly rotted with scribes T2S R6W S31 BT visible.

**RESTORATION** September 15, 1988

Var. 21 1/2 E

Set a 1 1/2"x 30" Aluminum pipe with 3 3/4" cap, 28" in ground, in mound of stone, marked "STATE OF OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY T2S R7W R6W S25 S30 S36 S31 1988 LS1998", and from which a:

- 14" Fir bears S48E 22.7 ft. to face; scribed T2SR6WS31BT.
- 11" Fir bears S58W 15.6 ft. to face; scribed T2SR7WS36BT.
- 8" Fir bears N38E 27.4 ft. to face; scribed T2SR6WS30BT.
- 24" Fir bears N18W 17.9 ft. to face; scribed T2SR7WS25BT.

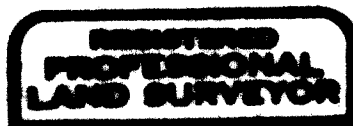
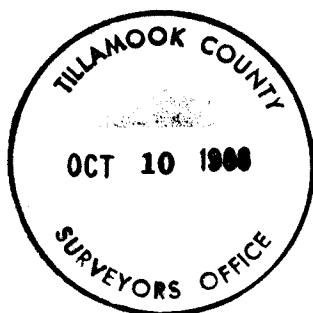
Metal location poster on new BTs.
