

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 21 and 28, T2S, R7W, W.M.,  
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Albert P. Wilson, August 2, 1891.

Post; missing.

5" Vine Maple bears N32E 30 lks.; missing.  
10" Hemlock bears S30W 21 lks.; missing.

RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE2311, December 31, 1951 (Book 2,  
page 96, Tillamook Co. Records.)

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in  
ground, in mound of stone; in place.

90" Burnt out Fir stub bears S60E 37.5 ft.; now a 40"x8 ft.  
high badly broken and rotted stub with axe visible.

80" Fir stump bears N37E 101.5 ft.; now a 80" stump with  
scribes BT visible.

Yellow metal location poster on 40" Hemlock stub bears N75W  
18 lks.; now a 40"x3 ft. high broken stub, tag laying on  
ground. Placed poster on remaining portion of stub.

a:

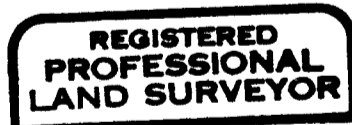
16" Fir bears N05 1/2W 45.9 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S21BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

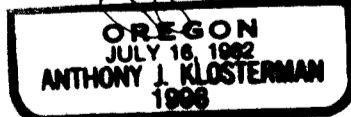
3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
