

REWITNESSED CORNER FOR STATE OF OREGON - DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 12 and 13, T1N, R10W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by C.J. Handley, July 5, 1873.
Post, in mound; missing.

10" Hemlock bears N12W 9 lks.; now a 26"x6 ft. high rotted stump with axe work visible on bark, face open and rotted.

7" Hemlock bears S30E 22 lks.; missing.

RESTORATION by O.R. Miller of Longview Fibre Co., July 25, 1950, Book 3, page 16, Tillamook County Records).

Iron pipe; found a 1 1/8" aluminum pipe 12" above ground, in place.

28" Hemlock bears N72E 18.2 ft.; missing.

24" Hemlock bears S21W 19.0 ft.; now approximately 40" windfall with scribes visible on partially closed face.

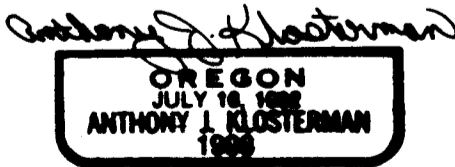
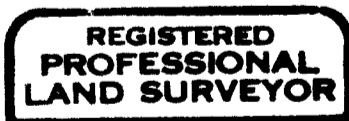

Placed a yellow plastic cap marked "LS 1998", in above pipe, and from which a:

8" Hemlock bears S89E 4.0 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S13BT.
19" Hemlock bears N52W 15.7 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S12BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.
3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
