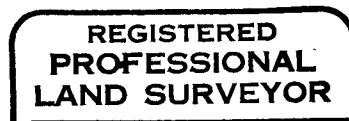
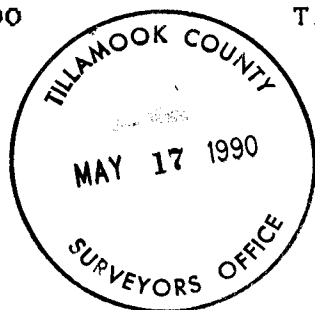
Monument Location
