I found a 2" iron pipe with a wood plug and a brass nail approximately 1.0' deep in the sand. I set a 5/8" iron rod with a 3" brass cap inside of the found iron pipe and encased in a 10" concrete cylinder.

History of Found Monument

The found monument is the original monument for this subdivision, see Tillamook County Surveyors map #C- 263.

New Accessories

Power Pole #252501 bears S.15*W. 3.17', the distance was measured to a finish nail with a brass washer in a scribed triangle on the East side of the pole.

4" spruce bears N.84*W. 10.24', the distance was measured to a finish nail with a brass washer in a small axe blaze on the Southerly side of the tree.

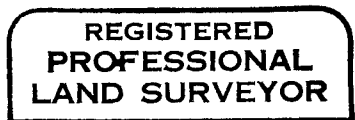
Location of Monument
