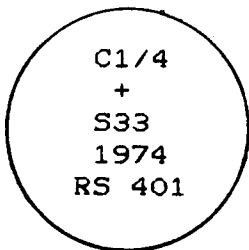

I set a 10" cast iron monument case around found 1 1/2" iron pipe with 3" Oregon State Board of Forestry bronze cap. See Tillamook County Surveyors map # B-663.

History of found monument

I found this corner to be as described on map B-663. And its' accessory evidence found and/or set at that time to now be as listed below:

27" spruce N.89 1/2*W. 48.0'; (now 49", face overgrown, 2 O.S.B. F. yellow location posters attached).

*16" hemlock S.65*E. 90.6'; (now 23", scribe marks visible on partially overgrown face).

New Accessory

*72" hat section post S.55*E. 7.2'.

*indicates yellow Tillamook County location poster attached.

Monument location

This corner is located approximately 2.0' NW of the SE edge of the oil on Kilchis River Road, and approximately 7.5' NW of a 2 rail board fence.
