County, Oregon.

1 1/2"x40" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 36" in ground,
in mound of stone; in place.

60" Fir stump bears S28W 27.4 ft.; now badly rotted with scribes
C1/4 S4 BT RE2311 visible.

36" Fir stump bears S19E 25.4 ft.; now rotted with scribes
C1/4 S4 BT visible.

Var. 21 1/2 E

From the above pipe with marks "LS1998 1990" added, a:

13" Fir bears N75W 6.0 ft. to face; scribed C1/4S4BT.

10" Fir bears S17 1/2W 16.85 ft. to face; scribed C1/4S4BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

Also 1953 metal location poster on 36" Fir stump BT.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
