4907 Third St., Tillamook, Oregon 97141

One quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 36, T2N, R8W, W.M.,
Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Henry Meldrum, August 20, 1891.

Post; found post hole in roots of 72" x 3 ft. high badly rotted Fir
stub.

7" Hemlock bears N24E 66 lks.; found 9" x 18" long portion of
badly rotted and uprooted stub, out of place. No scribes
visible.

24" Hemlock bears S30E 35 lks.; now a 34" x 7 ft. high rotted Fir
stump with portions of scribes visible. This tree was about
34" when scribed.

Ridge bears S89 50W 2.42 chains; in place, horizontal distance
143 ft.

Var. 21 1/2 E

Set a 1 1/2"x30" Aluminum pipe with 3 3/4" cap marked "STATE OF OREGON
DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY T2N R8W 1/4 S25 S36 1990 LS1998, 28" in ground,
from which a:

14" Fir bears N49E 17.8 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S25BT.

10" Fir bears S36 1/2W 11.1 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S36BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
