I found a 2" iron pipe with a wooden plug and nail approximately 24" below the surface of the ground. I set a 1 1/2" iron pipe with a 3" brass cap above the found iron pipe, and encased in a 10" concrete cylinder.

History of Found Monument

The found monument reset by the sanitary authority after sewer construction in about 1970, (see Tillamook County Surveyors map #B-726, Also see map #A-5960).

I found a 3/4" iron pipe with a yellow cap inscribed "PE 3510" Easterly 0.21', (See Tillamook County Surveyors Map #B-726).

I found a 3/4" iron pipe 0.7' Easterly, (Unknown Origin).

I found a steel fence post alongside of the corner, (I reset approximately 1.5' Easterly).

New Accessory

72" light hat section post 1.5' North.

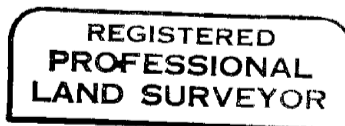
Location of Monument
