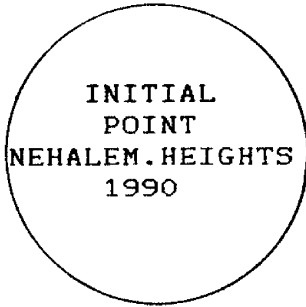


TILLAMOOK COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE

Initial Point
Nehalem Heights
In Section 27 T.3N., R.10W., W.M.



I found a 2" diameter iron pipe 6" deep, no plug. I set a 5/8" iron rod with a 3" Tillamook County Surveyors brass cap inside of the found iron pipe and encased in a 10" concrete cylinder flush with the surface of ground.

History of Found Monument

The found monument is the original monument set for this initial point, see Tillamook County Surveyors map #C-339. (Also see Tillamook County County Surveyors map #A-3373).

New Accessories

9" pine S.30*W. 2.81', the distance was measured to a finish nail with a Tillamook County Surveyors brass washer in a small blaze facing the initial point.

Sewer manhole N.42*E. 13.21', the distance was measured to a punch mark with an X on the Southwesterly rim.

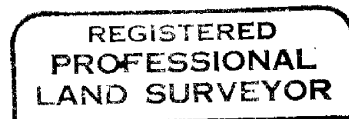
Location of Monument
