4"X 4"X 52" white painted cedar post 1.0' SE; (Found rotted off laying on ground).

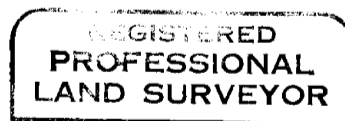
