SET: POST IN A MOUND OF STONE

1967 TILLAMOOK COUNTY C.S. 4138  
C.S. 4301

FOUND: OLD RUSTED OFF 2" IRON PIPE  
NEW: SET A 1 1/2" IRON ROD INSIDE OF OLD PIPE, FROM WHICH;  
A "PK" NAIL IN THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE CONCRETE FOUNDATION  
OF AN OLD BOAT FACTORY BEARS N. 89 1/2° E., 59.56'.  
A 24" SPRUCE, SCRIBED "MCS14BTCS" BEARS N. 3 1/2° E.,  
210.51'.

1972 TILLAMOOK COUNTY CORNER NOTES  
NEW: SET A 2" IRON PIPE WITH 3" BRASS CAP IN CONCRETE AT THE  
POSITION OF THE OLD IRON PIPE AND BAR.

LINCOLN COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE VISITED CORNER MARCH 1991  
FOUND: A 3" BRASS CAP, MARKED AS SHOWN, FIRMLY SET IN CONCRETE  
PROTRUDING 1' ABOVE THE SURFACE, (TILLAMOOK COUNTY, 1972) FROM  
WHICH;  
A P.K. NAIL IN THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF AN OLD CONCRETE  
FOUNDATION BEARS EAST, 59.62' (TILLAMOOK COUNTY, 1967).  
A 37" SPRUCE WITH A HEALED FACE AND A TILLAMOOK COUNTY TAG BEARS  
N. 4° E., 212.6' (TILLAMOOK COUNTY, 1967).  
NEW: A CARSONITE POST WAS SET 4' SOUTH.  
AN ORANGE PAINTED BAND AND LINCOLN COUNTY TAG WERE PLACED ON THE  
SPRUCE BEARING TREE. BEARINGS WERE DETERMINED BY HAND COMPASS  
AND DISTANCES WERE MEASURED WITH A WILD DI-2000 EDM.

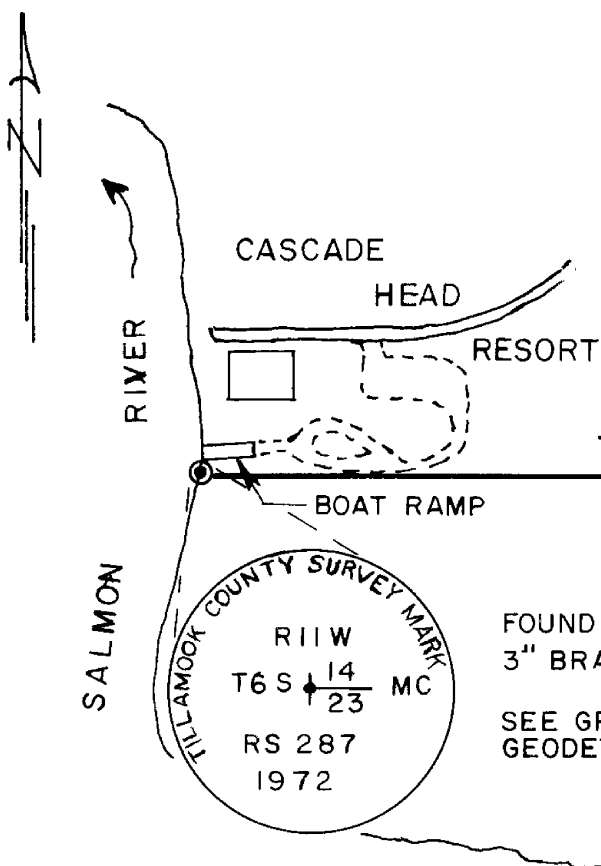
SUMMARY: NO ORIGINAL EVIDENCE WAS RECOVERED IN THIS SURVEY. IN  
1967, TILLAMOOK COUNTY (C.S. 4138 AND 4301) FOUND A 2" IRON PIPE  
AND SET A 1 1/2" IRON ROD INSIDE IT. IN 1972, TILLAMOOK COUNTY  
REPLACED THE OLD PIPE AND ROD WITH A BRASS CAP IN CONCRETE. THE  
1972 TILLAMOOK COUNTY BRASS CAP WAS RECOVERED IN THIS SURVEY.
