History of found monument

I found this monument to be as described on T.C.S. Map #B-737 and in T.C.S. Rewitness Book 6 at page 10 and the references found and/or set at that time to now be as follows:

original 10" hemlock N.20 W. 12 lks., reported on above as 20" hemlock stump N.20 W. 8.0'; (Now just a pile of hemlock rot at position).

original 10" hemlock S.2 W. 13 lks., reported on above as 20" hemlock stump S.2 W. 13 lks; (Not found position under brush pile).

*(B-737) 20" fir N.54 W. 11.7'; (Found, now a 16" fir srump 2' tall, the bottom of the face with the scribe mark "T" is all that remains).

*(B-737) 30" fir S.36 E. 33.9'; (Found, now a 32" fir stump 4' tall, scribing visible on partially sawed open face at position).

*72" light hat section post West 1.5'.

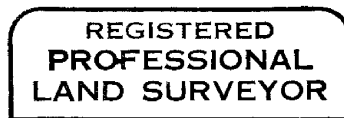
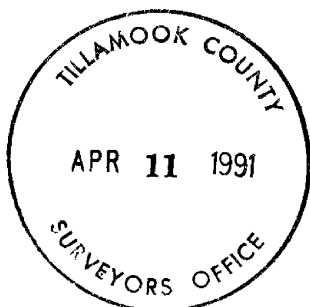
Location of Monument
