History of found monument

I found this monument to be as described on said T.C.S. Rewitness and the references found and/or set at that time to now be as follows:

Original 40" hemlock S.20°E. 17 lks., reported on above as a 48" hemlock stub 2' high face and scribes rotted away; (Now gone).

Original 36" hemlock N.10°W. 30 lks., reported on above as N.10°W. 33 lks. a 37" uproot backcast of scribes "BT" visible, both faces rotted away, roots and root hole in place; (Found, now a rotten pile of wood, unidentifiable).

(Book 2 Page 446) 12" Hemlock N.55 1/2°E. 16.0'; (Found, now a 12" stub 3' tall, rotten, scribing visible on partially healed face).

(Book 2 Page 446) 16" Hemlock S.30 1/2°E. 14.4'; (Found, now a 21" rotten stump 5' tall, face overgrown).

(Book 2 Page 446) 4"X 4"X 48" white painted cedar post 1.0' NE; (Found, rotted off).

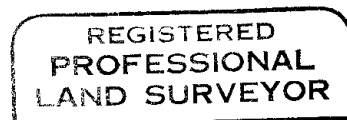
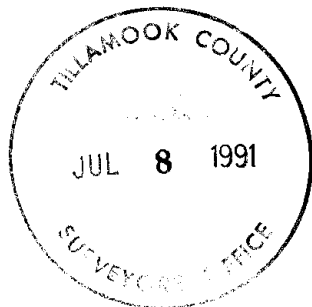
Location of Monument
