History of found monument

There is no record of who set The monument found at the corner location. References found from T.C.S. Map #B-293 are as follows:

Centerline of PTBRR (A.K.A. NASRR) S.88 14'35"E. 489.18'; (Found at S.88 14'35"E. 489.15').

6"X 6"X 36" concrete post (with brass pin) protruding 6" above the ground N.2 24'52"E. shown on map, calculated to be N.2 24'30"E. 238.11'; (Found at N.2 25'38"E. 238.30').

Basis of Bearings for above is N.17 39'50"W. along the centerline of the above said railroad on the tangent East of this 1/4 corner (T.C.S. map #B-293).

New Accessory

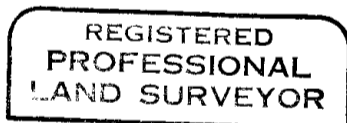
Power Pole #058501 N.71 W. 104.38'. The distance was measured to a finish nail with a brass T.C.S. washer in the side center of the pole.

16" pine N.72 E. 85.37'. This tree was not scribed as it was in the front lawn of a private land owner. The distance was measured to a finish nail with brass T.C.S. washer in a scar 3.5' high on the tree.

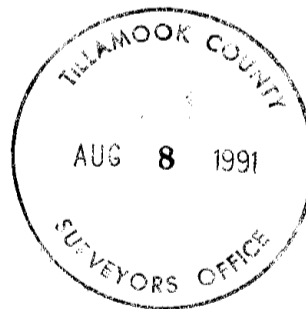
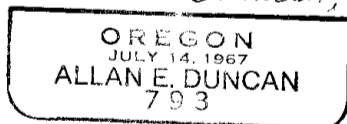
Finish nail with T.C.S. washer in a 6"X 6" treated east gate post in The Port of Tillamook Bay Fence S.22 E. 34.00'.

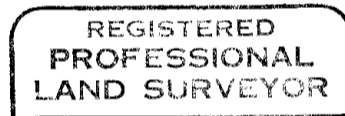
Location of Monument
