30" Hemlock bears N31 1/2W 39 lks.; missing.

12" Hemlock bears N30 1/2E 89 lks.; now root crown.

12" Hemlock bears S35W 110 lks.; now 12" x 3 ft. high badly  
rotted stub with no scribes visible.

16" Hemlock bears S67 3/4E 70 lks.; missing.

page 135, Tillamook County Records).

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in ground;  
in place.

5' Fir stump bears S62 1/2E 39.6 ft.; now badly rotted with  
scribes S5 BT visible on thin shell.

4" Alder bears N45E 22.5 ft.; now 9" face closed.

56" Fir stump bears S64W 68.2 ft.; now badly rotted with  
scribes T2S R7W S6 BT 2311 visible on solid face.

56" Fir stub bears N30W 25.9 ft.; now badly rotted with axe  
work visible on bottom of rotted out face.

13" Fir bears N01E 53.4 ft. to face; scribed T1SR7WS32BT.

9" Fir bears S38E 43.2 ft. to face; scribed T2SR7WS5BT.

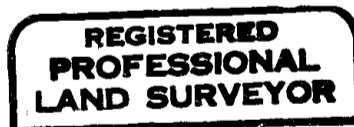
