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History of found monument

I found this monument to be as described in T.C.S. Rewitness Book 6 at page 98 and the references found and/or set at that time to now be as follows:

(Original) 10" hemlock N.85\*E. 16 lks., reported on T.C.S. rewitness card #602 as a 20" blown down hemlock with healed witness face, and by B.L.M. in said Rewitness Book as a decayed hemlock snag with scribe marks visible; (Found, now a rotten uproot scribing 1/4S BT visible. The face is located approximately 2' Westerly of the new NE Bearing Tree).

(Rewitness Card #602) 6" hemlock S.42\*E 14.4', reported in Book 6 Page 98 as an 8" hemlock S.44\*E. 21 1/2 lks with healed blaze; (Found, now an 11" hemlock with healed blaze S.42\*E. 13.96' to a finish nail with a brass washer in a small blaze).

(Rewitness Card #602) 10" hemlock N.31\*W 10.3', reported in Book 6 Page 98 as a 16" hemlock N.31\*W. 16 lks with healed blaze; (Found, now a 20" hemlock with healed blaze N.25\*W. 9.31' to a finish nail with a brass washer in a small blaze).

I also found a steel fence post with a U.S.F.S. yellow attention tag 3.2' Southerly and an orange painted 1/2" X 60" iron pipe driven 2' in the ground Easterly 0.8'.

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New Accessories

\*14" hemlock N.77\*E. 14.09' scribed 1/4S10BTCS. Measurements were taken to a finish nail with a brass washer between th B and the T.

\*19" hemlock S.50\*W. 18.32' scribed 1/4S9BTCS. Measurements were taken to a finish nail with a brass washer between th B and the T.

\*84" light hat section post North 1.4'.

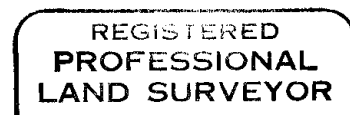
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Location of Monument

This corner is located approximately 100' Northerly of a small creek in a thick stand of hemlock trees. I also found a U.S.F.S. yellow metal location poster on a 13" fir approximately 30' Southwest of a logging road inscribed "stay on ridge approx. S.50\*W. 600' to 1/4 corner".
