W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Albert P. Wilson, October 1, 1891.
Post; missing.

- 20" Fir bears S71 1/2W 31 lks.; now a 24" badly rotted snag
with scribes S29 visible. Cruiser marks visible above
face.
- 24" Hemlock bears N81 1/2W 28 lks.; now a badly rotted root
crown, bears N88 1/2W.
- 14" Hemlock bears S38E 25 lks.; missing.
- 40" Fir bears N57 1/2E 44 lks.; now a 50" badly rotted stump
with axe work visible on rotted out face.

RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE2311, November 19, 1952 (Book 2,
page 235, Tillamook County Records).

- 1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in
ground; now in place, in mound of stone.
- 66" Fir stump bears N58 1/2E 37.6 ft.; now rotted with
scribes T1S R7W S21 BT RE231 visible.
- 50" Fir stump bears S81 1/2E 31.0 ft.; now badly rotted with
scribes S28 BT visible.
- 65" Fir stump bears S46 1/2W 34.7 ft.; now badly rotted with
no scribes visible.

- 9" Fir bears S29W 20.6 ft. to face; scribed T1SR7WS29BT.
- 8" Fir bears S34E 12.6 ft. to face; scribed T1SR7WS28BT.
- 9" Fir bears N51W 14.2 ft. to face; scribed T1SR7WS20BT.
- 12" Fir bears N16E 25.6 ft. to face; scribed T1SR7WS21BT.
